Notification of correction the Motor News regarding AC Servo Motor & Driver optional product labeling compliance with revised WEEE Directive 2012/19/EU

Due to the revised WEEE Directive 2012/19/EU effective from August 15, 2018, the range of products subject to compliance has been expanded, and it is now mandatory to display the recycling mark (crossed-out wheelie bin with a bar) on the products.

In our Motor News dated July 31, 2018, titled "Notice of Product Labeling Compliance with Revised WEEE Directive 2012/19/EU for AC Servo Amplifier and Motor Options," we had previously communicated about the option cables. However, according to WEEE FAQ 3.8, cables sold for use with other electrical and electronic equipment are not covered by this directive. Therefore, the option cables and consoles do not display the recycling mark.

We sincerely apologize for the delay in this notification and would like to make the following correction to the content of the Motor News dated July 31, 2018.
